# CoAchieve

CoAchieve is a Kirklees-wide employment service for people 18 years or over who have experienced drug and/or alcohol problems and who are in recovery or stable enough to engage in work or work like activities.

CoAchieve is a partnership of two organisations: Horton Housing and The Basement Recovery Project. Working together, we provide a holistic support package encompassing, support around recovery, and employment, training and education.



## Who is CoAchieve for?

You can access our service if

- you are living in the Kirklees area
- you are 18 years or over
- you have experienced drug and/or alcohol problems, and you are in recovery, or you are stable and able to engage in work or work like activities.

## What We Can Help You With

CoAchieve will enable you to access and/or remain in employment. We achieve this by working closely with you when you access the service.

### We will:

- Provide an accessible, friendly and safe environment for “employment to education” support, and routes into recovery.
- Actively encourage your participation in developing and achieving your long-term goals.
- Provide a range of flexible and appropriately tailored courses, social enterprise, volunteering and work experience opportunities for you.
- Provide skilled navigators who will provide 1 to 1 support to enable you to access recovery focused services.
- Provide ETE Case Workers who can assist you to access opportunities that will support you to fulfil your future employment goals.
- Work with partners in the housing, education, training and health fields.
- Ask you, our partners and other stakeholders to tell us what we can do to continuously improve our service.

### You will:

- Have greater confidence to explore, choose and participate in education, training and employment-related activities.
- Gain and sustain suitable employment.
- Access and remain within recovery services.
- Experience reduced episodes of relapse.
- Have improved health and sense of wellbeing.



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
